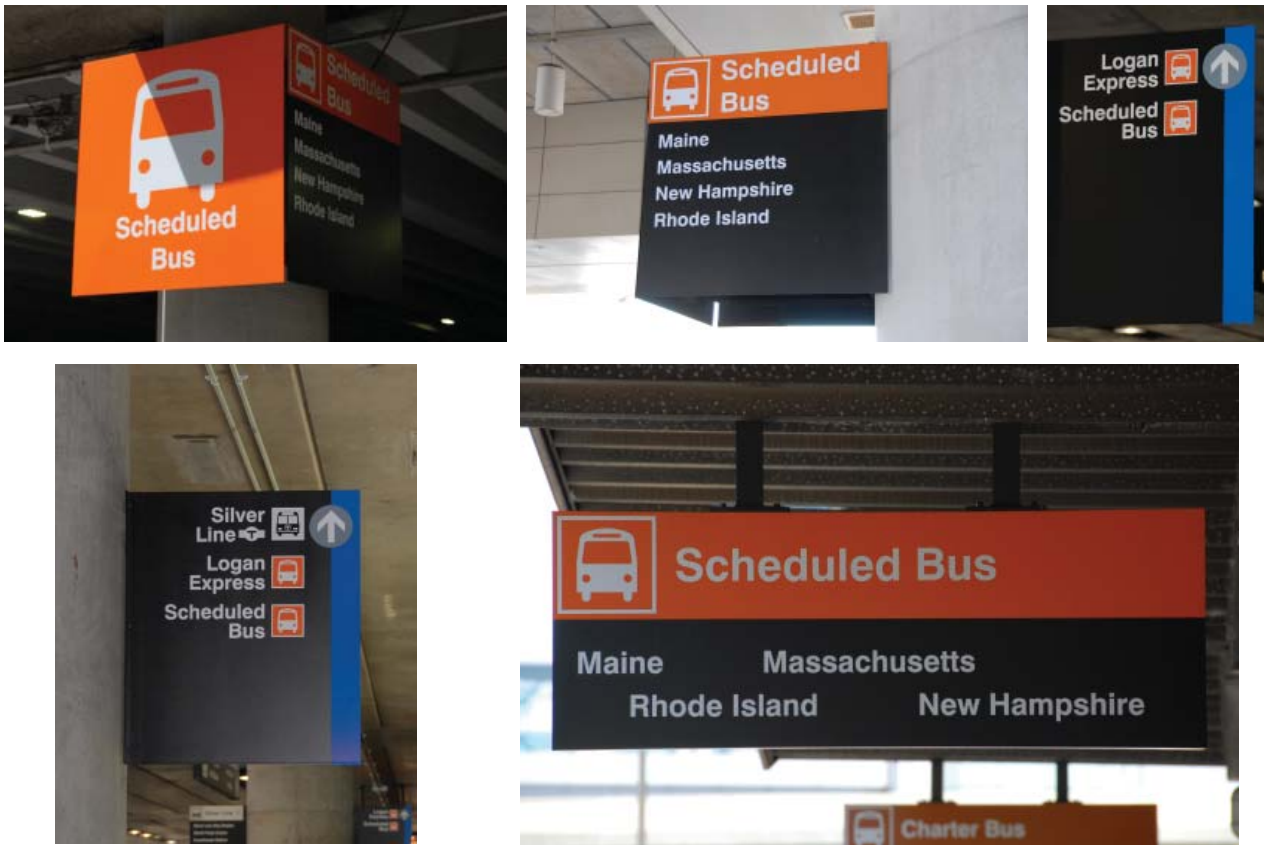


All Dartmouth Coach and Concord Coach Buses stop at specific locations at each Terminal. These locations are marked by signs that are different, but similar. Examples of the Bus Stop Signs, and directional signs leading to them, are shown below.



A typical Bus Stop looks like the pictures below.



All of the Terminals at Logan Airport have exit doors that are sequentially numbered and clearly marked, inside and outside. Below are examples of those door numbers.



The letter on the door number indicates the Terminal, the first digit indicates the floor number (arrivals are on first floor and departures are on the second floor) and the remaining two digits are the actual door number, ascending from left to right as you stand inside the terminal looking out. The door numbers adjacent to the respective Scheduled Bus Stops are as follows;

Terminal A – Exit door A105 and the stop is just to your right.

Terminal B (US Air side, or B1) – Exit door B101 and the stop is right in front of the door.

Terminal B (American/United side, or B2) – Exit door B115 and the stop is just outside the door.

Terminal C – Exit door C110, which is the farthest door to the right from baggage claim (it's a long walk).

Terminal E – Exit door E107 and the stop is just outside the door.
